Who is the course for?

The CT ABRSM Plus combines two of our highly respected letter-bearing qualifications: the Certificate of Teaching (CT ABRSM) and Principles of Teaching diploma (DipABRSM) exam. The course is suitable for instrumental and vocal teachers looking for further professional development who meet the course prerequisites.

To apply

You must:

- be able to attend all sessions on the dates specified at the Singapore centre
- be teaching a minimum of five pupils on a regular basis
- have a minimum of one year's teaching experience
- be 21 years old or over
- have passed ABRSM Grade 8 Practical in the instrument taught, or have a permitted substitution

If you wish to take the Principles of Teaching diploma (DipABRSM) you must:

- have also passed ABRSM Grade 6 Theory (1992 syllabus) or a permitted substitution

Course fees 2012

- The total course fee payment is S\$5900 nett inclusive of an administration charge and a registration fee. You will be eligible for the special discount rate of S\$5350 nett if you choose to pay using the early bird payment options (2a, 3 or 4) detailed right.
- The course fee includes one attempt for the Principles of Teaching diploma (DipABRSM) exam. Students who either fail the CT ABRSM, or do not attempt the diploma, are deemed to have forfeited this opportunity and no refund will be given.
- If you are unable to be present for your diploma, you should notify ABRSM immediately, giving your reasons for non-attendance. Provided your withdrawal is made necessary by an unavoidable event (such as illness or bereavement), a voucher may be issued, at ABRSM's discretion, entitling you to re-enter the diploma exam at the next session. No further attempts are permissible.
- Payment by crossed cheque should be made payable to **Singapore Symphonia Co Ltd**.
- The registration fee of S\$600 is payable on application and is non-refundable except in circumstances where the course is cancelled.

Financial support from an employer or other sponsor

It may be possible for students to receive a contribution towards their course fees from their employer or another sponsor. If this is the case, a signed letter of support from the sponsor, should be enclosed with the application. The letter should indicate the extent of the financial contribution and give full details of the sponsor. Failure to enclose a letter of support with the application may result in a student not being accepted on to the course.
