Introductory Jazz Course

Who is the course for?

ABRSM jazz courses provide an excellent introduction to jazz for piano, woodwind or brass teachers. The courses are open to anyone interested in expanding their teaching repertoire or wishing to explore jazz with their students.

To apply

You do not need any formal qualifications to enrol on our jazz courses, however, you should be an instrumental music teacher. No prior experience of jazz is necessary for the introductory course.

The courses have a strong practical element, so you'll need to bring your instrument along with you (except pianists).

Course fees

- £295 which includes refreshments, a light lunch each day, a set of ABRSM Grade 1 Jazz publications and entry to the Grade 1 Jazz exam on the final day
- Early applicants (before 30 November 2009) and participants of a jazz taster day qualify for a discounted rate of £250

Intermediate Jazz Course

Who is the course for? The Intermediate Jazz Course is particularly suited to piano, woodwind or brass teachers who already have some experience of teaching jazz but would like guidance on how to move up a level. It is the ideal next step for teachers who have already attended an ABRSM Introductory Jazz Course.

To apply You do not need any formal qualifications to enrol on our jazz courses, however, you should be an instrumental music teacher. In addition, the Intermediate Jazz Course requires a reasonable understanding of the basics of jazz teaching.

The courses have a strong practical element, so you'll need to bring your instrument along with you (except pianists).

Venue & dates The Intermediate Jazz Course in 2010 is a residential course in Hertfordshire, at Benslow Music Trust. On each residential weekend, full board will be provided from supper on Friday to tea on Sunday. Alternatively, a non-residential option is available.

Closing date The closing date for applications for the Intermediate Jazz Course is Friday 4 June 2010.

Course fees

- £480 residential. There are a limited number of en-suite rooms available (allocated on a first come, first served basis). The remaining rooms have shared facilities (one bathroom to approximately three bedrooms), or
- £450 non-residential

Fees include a set of ABRSM Grade 2 or 3 Jazz publications and entry to the Grade 2 or 3 Jazz exam on the final day.

A £200 non-refundable registration fee is due upon application for this course. The remaining balance is due by Monday 31 May 2010.
