Each year the Associated Board awards International Scholarships to enable students to study at one of the four Royal Schools of Music in the UK. In addition to satisfying the formal entry requirements of the School or Schools to which they apply, candidates will be expected to demonstrate outstanding musical promise and proficiency in their principal study or chosen field. They will normally have achieved a standard at least equivalent to a pass at DipABRSM Music Performance for undergraduate performance and postgraduate conducting and composition courses, and at LRSM Music Performance for postgraduate performing courses.

The Scholarships will comprise

- Four undergraduate awards; one tenable at each of the Royal Schools of Music for a four-year undergraduate performance course
- Four postgraduate awards; one tenable at each of the Royal Schools of Music for a one-year or two-year performance, conducting or composition course

The Scholarships will provide

- Tuition fees for the designated course
- A grant of £4,500 sterling per year towards living expenses, normally paid by termly instalment
- The return fare home upon satisfactory completion of the course

It should be noted that students will require additional personal funds for living expenses in the UK. Advice on this matter may be sought from the individual Royal Schools.

Conditions

Holders of Associated Board scholarships are required to support the work of ABRSM. Activities may include the following:

- Co-operating with ABRSM for promotion/publicity purposes, e.g. articles in *Libretto*, promotional videos
- Assisting ABRSM with promotion/publicity in the scholar's own country
- Contributing to the ongoing work of ABRSM during the scholarship period e.g. by attendance/performance at concerts, seminars or CT ABRSM activities
- Including reference to their ABRSM scholarship in CV and publicity material
- Submitting a written report to the Chief Executive of ABRSM at the end of each academic year of tenure of the scholarship
- Representing ABRSM as one of its scholarship holders and acting as an ambassador for ABRSM as requested

Eligibility

- You must be a national of a country that is not a member of the European Union
- You will not be eligible to apply if you have been living or studying in the UK for a period of more than one year immediately preceding 31 January in the year of entry to the course or if you have Home Fee Status.*
- For undergraduate study you should normally be at least 17 years of age by 31 January in the year of entry to the course. Postgraduates should normally be at least 21 years of age by 31 January in the year of entry.

* Home Fee Status will be applicable to any non-EU resident who can demonstrate that they have been ordinarily resident (i.e. not for the purposes of full-time education) in the UK for three years prior to the beginning of their studies. In cases of doubt, please seek advice from the Registries/Admissions Offices of the various Royal Schools.

Application procedure

Stage 1

Application for a place at the Royal Schools of Music

If you are eligible for consideration for a scholarship you must separately apply for admission to a course at one or more of the Royal Schools. You may apply to as many of the Royal Schools as you wish but, in each case, you must observe the admission procedures of the individual Royal School. This will involve the payment of the School's normal entrance fee and, where you cannot attend for the audition in person, the submission of a recording of your playing according to the School's stated requirements. Prospectuses and application forms may be obtained by writing to the Royal Schools or by request via the Internet. Addresses are given below. You must adhere to the closing dates set by each Royal School.

Submission of scholarship eligibility form to the ABRSM

In addition to making your application(s) for a place at the Royal Schools, you must also complete the attached eligibility form and return it to the Chief Executive of the Associated Board of the Royal Schools of Music to arrive no later than 31 January in the year of proposed entry to a course.

Stage 2

If after the completion of Stage 1 there are any unawarded scholarships at any Royal School, consideration may be given by that School to candidates who did not make direct application to it. You are asked to place in order of preference not only the Schools to which you have applied direct, but also any other Royal School(s) at which you may wish to be considered for a scholarship. Preferences for Schools to which you have not applied directly will only be taken into account at this later stage, following consideration of all first-choice applications. Scholarship applications considered in this second-stage process will not incur further cost to the candidate.

Awarding of Scholarships

Decisions on the offer of scholarships will normally be made in March of each year. Successful applicants will normally be expected to take up their places in the following September/October, with the possible exception of those students for whom the academic year runs from January to December. Scholarships will not be deferrable.
